

It is with the deepest sadness that we must share news of the death on Thanksgiving of Alexander Byron Hero, a member of the Class of 2010 and president of his class at The Hill.

While we do not know details at this time, Mr. Hero did share that Alexander came home to New York City for the holiday to visit his parents, Byron and Camille, and sister Gabrielle, as well as friends.

Mr. Hero has shared the following information with the School:

"Alexander Byron Hero died suddenly on Thanksgiving Day. Born March 10, 1991, he was a 2010 graduate of The Hill School, where he was President of the School, winner of the Award for Excellence in Leadership, and captain of the varsity soccer and baseball teams. He graduated from Amherst College, where he majored in religion and was the starting center fielder on four record-setting varsity baseball teams.

He is survived by his parents, Byron and Camille, and sister, Gabrielle. Alexander's life was defined by emotion. He was passionate about sports, fought for fairness and railed against injustice, cherished his many friends and teammates, and, most of all, was lovingly devoted to his father, mother, and sister.
